

Your Guide to Winston Salem

With a population of about 225,000 people, Winston-Salem, North Carolina is the home of Wake Forest University. It is located in North Carolina's Piedmont Triad and within hours to the Blue Ridge mountains and NC coastal beaches. Winston Salem (or just Winston as many locals call it) is The City of the Arts, as it was the first city in the US with its own Arts Council. You'll see this dedication to cultural enrichment in the many art galleries, film and music festivals, block parties, and city-wide initiatives that you'll find throughout the city.

Best Asian:

TRANSPORTATION

Most Wake Forest University campus facilities and neighboring communities are either within walking distance or accessible by public transportation. Owning a car is not necessary while you are here, although many students choose to purchase a bicycle, new or used.

Transportation in and around Wake Forest University and Winston Salem

- **Ride the Wake** - Wake Forest University offers a **free weekday shuttle service** to and from campus for all students who live in nearby apartment complexes to include Crowne Polo, Crowne Park, Corners at Crystal Lake, Alaris Village, Deacon Ridge, and Crowne Oaks. In addition, the [WFU Shuttle system](http://facilities.wfu.edu/transport/ride-the-wake/downtown-shuttle-schedule/) also offers free service shuttle to [downtown Winston-Salem](http://facilities.wfu.edu/transport/ride-the-wake/downtown-shuttle-schedule/) (<http://facilities.wfu.edu/transport/ride-the-wake/downtown-shuttle-schedule/>) and [Hanes Mall, Fresh Market, and River Birch](http://facilities.wfu.edu/transport/ride-the-wake/downtown-shuttle-schedule/). - **City of Winston-Salem Public Transportation** - Winston Salem does offer a limited public bus transit system. The Winston-Salem Transit Authority (WSTA) offers service between campus and the downtown area ([Route 5](http://www.wstransit.com/wp-content/uploads/2014/02/Day-Routes.pdf)) and from downtown to the Hanes Mall area ([Route 18](http://www.wstransit.com/wp-content/uploads/2014/02/Day-Routes.pdf)). The cost is \$10 per ten ride pass and additional schedules and a helpful map can be found [here](http://www.wstransit.com/wp-content/uploads/2014/02/Day-Routes.pdf) (<http://www.wstransit.com/wp-content/uploads/2014/02/Day-Routes.pdf>).
- **Airport Shuttle** - An airport shuttle leaves from the Benson University Center. For more information on the schedule and to reserve a ride, please visit their [website](http://airportshuttle.benson.wfu.edu/). (<http://airportshuttle.benson.wfu.edu/>)
- **Wake Forest- Zipcar** - Students who chose not to purchase a vehicle may wish to consider the [zipcar](http://www.zipcar.com/wfu/) (<http://www.zipcar.com/wfu/>) service, although you will still need to obtain a NC driver's license to use this service. Zipcar charges a yearly fee of \$25 to join, which enables members to reserve cars throughout the year. Actual costs for renting cars depends on total number of hours or days rented.

Owning a car and driving in North Carolina and on campus

- **Purchasing a WFU parking permit** - If you plan on purchasing a vehicle while you are here and plan to park on campus, you must purchase a permit or else you risk receiving a parking citation. - **Obtaining a driver's license** - If you plan on driving a car while you are in the U.S., you will need to obtain a North Carolina driving license. If you are not a licensed driver in the U.S., you will be required to take both the written and the road tests. If you are licensed to drive in another state, in most instances you will only be required to take the written portion of the test. Please note that the license will contain an expiration date that corresponds with the end date listed on your I-20/DS-2019 form.

Public Transportation throughout NC and the U.S.

There are several options for public transportation throughout North Carolina and the U.S.

- **PART shuttle** - The [PART shuttle](http://www.partnc.org/express-bus-routes/) (<http://www.partnc.org/express-bus-routes/>) travels throughout the Piedmont Triad and surrounding areas. One-way Fare to Piedmont Triad International Airport are \$2.40, where a PART Shuttle ride will connect you with the PART Regional Hub to make your transfer to Express Bus Routes into downtown Winston Salem where you can connect with a Winston Salem Transit Authority Bus. Pick up is outside of Delta Baggage Claim at the PART Bus Stop Sign. - **Megabus** - The [Megabus](#) travels from Charlotte or Durham to several major U.S. cities to include Washington D.C., Atlanta, and Richmond. the Megabus is usually a much cheaper option than flying.
- **Greyhound** - One of the largest bus companies in the U.S., [Greyhound](#) travels to most major cities in the States. The Greyhound station is located in downtown Winston-Salem on Trade Street.
- **Amtrak Train** - The [Amtrak](#) train service in Winston-Salem, travels to many major cities such as Washington D.C., New York, etc.

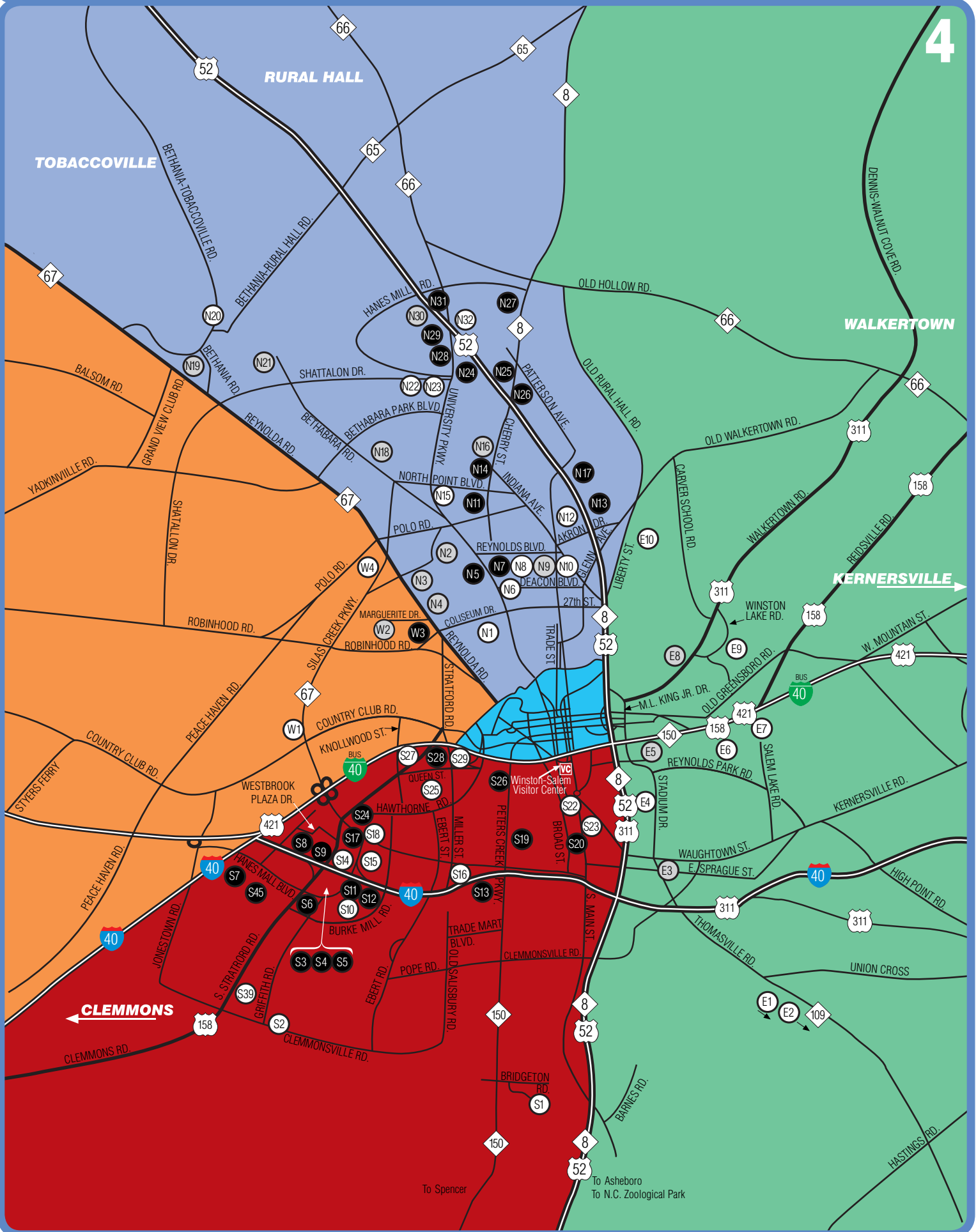

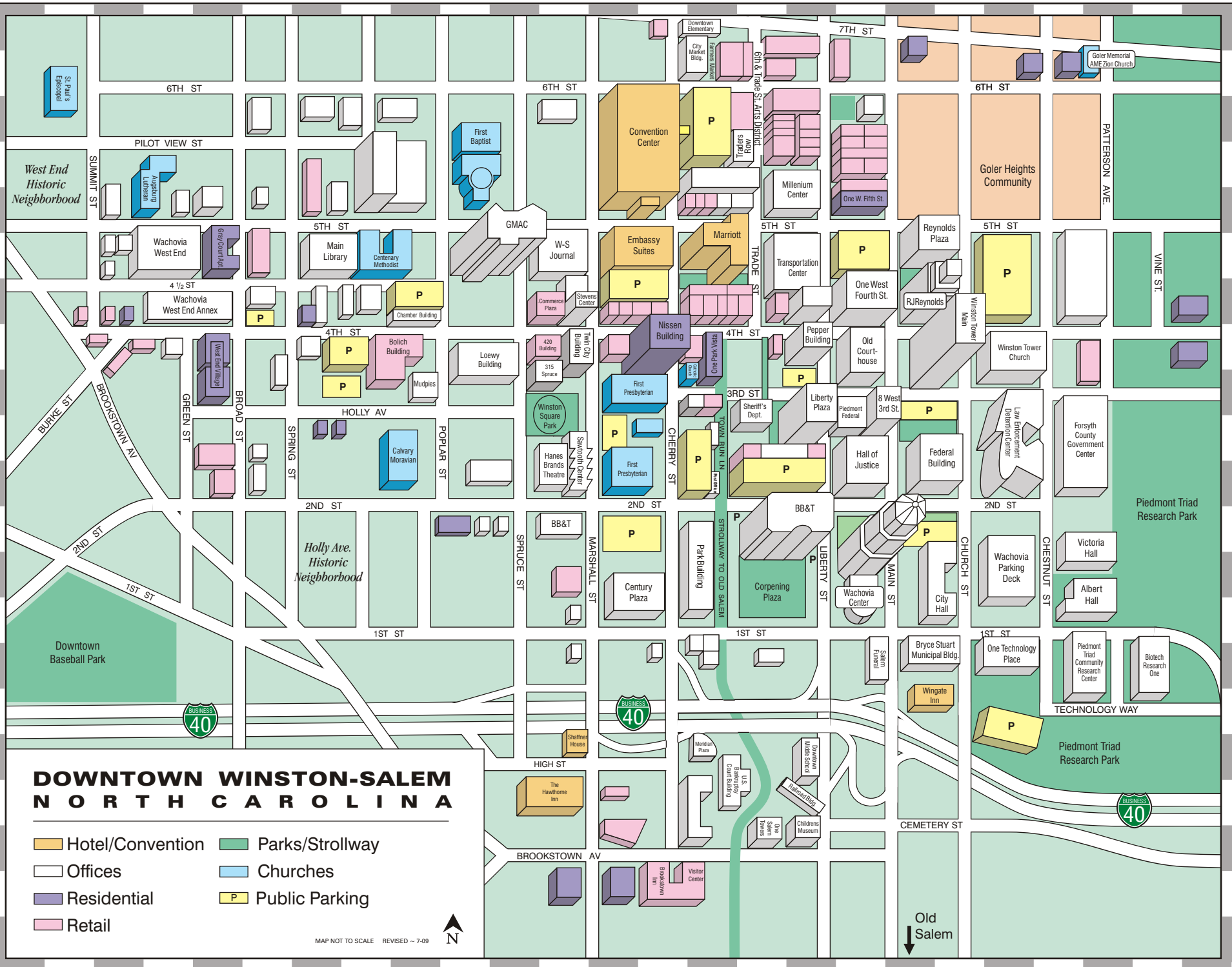
